Be Aware of the new Boating Regulations

All operators of powered vessels in Canada will require a Pleasure Craft Operator Card by Sept 15, 2009.* - It's the Law. Learn more about Operator Card requirements.

Question: "Do commercial operators need a Card?"

Answer: No. As long as you are operating your craft for commercial purposes then you are not required to show proof of competency. However, if you operate your vessel (or any other pleasure craft) for recreational purposes you are required to obtain and show the Card.
