

Please make sure your recycling is rinsed & clean. We cannot recycle containers that are not EMPTY.

Motor oil containers are not recyclable. (save for Household Hazardous waste day)

Clothing and other used items can be dropped off at the landfill FREE STORE. (we do not accept these items at the depot)



plastic toys (lego etc.), hard plastic water containers (ex. Nalgene bottles). ALL HARD PLASTIC EXLUDES AUTOMOTIVE LUBRICANT CONTAINERS

A municipal compost is available at the landfill. Composting can divert up to 50% of the waste from the landfill. Please note - ONLY compostable (not biodegradable) bags can go in the compost.



composting

Food scraps, teabags, coffee filters, soiled paper products like pizza boxes & napkins, waxed cartons, yard waste, sawdust, ect.

NOT - soiled toilet paper, pet feces, cigarettes, glass, plastic etc.



A Household Hazardous Waste Day will be held annually. Store your hazardous waste in a safe place until it can be disposed of safely.

WHAT IS HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Paints, thinners, solvents, cleaning products, pesticides, aerosol cans, motor oil, antifreeze, rechargable batteries, smoke alarms, fluorescent lights & some personal care items are examples of common hazaroud materials found in homes.
